

Position Outline

This position will have operational responsibility for the effective service delivery of Acute, Surgical, Aged Care Services, Health Information and Hospitality at the Leongatha campus of Gippsland Southern Health Service. A key objective of this position is to oversee the provision of patient centred care to patients, residents and clients within GSHS's acute, surgical and aged care services through effective and efficient leadership, active participation and competent business practice. The Director of Nursing will ensure services are customer and quality focused and that staff are engaged in a culture of continuous improvement. The position will ensure the strategic intent, operational directions and plans as directed by the CEO are delivered within the organisations systems and practices.
