GV Health is a leader in healthcare delivery in the Hume Region. Located in the north east of country Victoria, GV Health is only two hours from Melbourne and less than an hour from the Murray River. Its main sites are at Shepparton, Tatura and Rushworth, with additional services at Seymour, Benalla and Wodonga. The Shepparton Campus is the major acute referral hospital for the sub-region and has 280 beds - providing acute medical, surgical, obstetrics and gynaecology, paediatric, rehabilitation, intensive/coronary care, emergency care, mental health and geriatric care.

GV Health is currently undertaking a \$229 million redevelopment at its main campus in Shepparton, which includes a new renal dialysis unit, an expanded emergency department including satellite medical imaging, two new inpatient wards, extended theatre space, intensive care unit, a new kitchen, mortuary and the establishment of a Women's and Children's precinct featuring a new, special care nursery, paediatric ward and refurbished maternity ward.

The Executive Director Capital Projects, Infrastructure & Support Services is an integral part of the Executive Leadership team at GV Health and leads the Capital Projects, Infrastructure & Support Services portfolio across the health service. The Executive Director works closely with the Chief Executive, executive team members, the Department of Health and Human Services officers, the Victorian Health and Human Services Building Authority and is the prime source of strategic, tactical and operational advice in respect of all service provided within the Directorate.
