This position will work interchangeably with the senior finance team and CHRH management to prepare operating and capital budgets, monthly business forecasts, activity reporting and variance analysis, cash flow monitoring and forecasting. You will hold tertiary qualifications in accounting (preferably with CPA/CA accreditation) and have proven analytical and financial management skills with the ability to collate and critically analyse data.
